### Verify Completed Participant Paperwork in CircuiTree

#### In-Person PACE for Minors:

- Prior to the first day of the PACE for minors, camp directors must verify that all required medical and legal forms have be signed online by a parent or legal guardian.
- To verify all participants have signed required documents follow these steps:
  - 1. Login to the <u>CircuiTree Admin</u> site.
  - 2. Click on the three bold lines in the upper left corner of the screen.
  - 3. Select "Reports" from the menu.
  - 4. Select "Queries."
  - 5. Select "Registration" from the category dropdown menu.
  - 6. Select "All" from the dropdown menu.
  - 7. Click "Find" on the bottom left corner of the screen.
  - 8. Queries are listed in alphabetical order.
  - 9. To ensure all participants have a signed medical release on file, locate the "Signed Medical Forms" query: Identifies participants with a signed medical form on file.
    - Event Year: Current calendar year.
    - o Event Location: Area hosting PACE for Minors (i.e. Computer Science, Chess, Soccer).
    - Event (optional): Can be used to further narrow down a specific event if a location has several PACE for Minors registered.
  - 10. Missing Legal Terms query: Identifies participants that have missing signed legal terms (Talent Release, Pick Up Auth, Release and Indemnification, Cancellation Policy).
    - Event Year: Current calendar year.
    - Event Location: Area hosting PACE for Minors (i.e. Computer Science, Chess, Soccer).
    - Event (optional): Can be used to further narrow down a specific event if a location has several PACE for Minors registered.
